The marking scheme included some similar issues and an updated version has been provided. There could be a better breakdown of marks in places. As a suggestion, a breakdown to 5 marks maximum would

be good to aid consistency of marking. Question 1 seems to have had part 1(d) removed and marks reallocated since I looked at the exam paper itself. For questions 4 and 5, some question parts do not include a marking scheme. Hence guidelines 11 and 12 above are only partially complete, but could easily be completed without formal rechecking. 29/12/14
